

FIELD TRIP INFORMATION 2024

We are looking forward to your visit!

PARKING: Please park the bus and any other vehicles at LOT A, 138 Sudbury Rd Stow, MA 01775. After parking, have one person pay at the lot A Booth. The Apple Ambassadors will meet you near the lot A parking/Booth area for the hayride.

PAYMENT: You may pay by cash or check- please pay at the Lot A Booth; if paying by credit card ask the lot A Booth attendant to call Kristen for you and you can give her cc info over the phone; she can also send you a link to make the payment before field trip. 978-562-5666 x702 for payment over the phone while traveling to HPHO. Lastly if paying by PO - it needs to be sent in at least two weeks in advance of your trip to outings@honeypothill.com.

- We kindly ask that your group members consolidate all payments into one payment before arrival, please designate one person.

TIMING: The field trip begins at the time stated on your booking invoice. Field trips do not have a time limit, however, the hayride and apple picking takes about an hour depending on the group size. After those activities are done, you are free to take time to enjoy the farm animals, etc.

LUNCH info: You can bring your own lunch. We do not offer lunch options.

We have several picnic tables available, but they are first come, first serve. We do not take reservations for them.

DONUT/ CIDER PICK UP that are included: Please have adult(s) pick them up on the outside bakery window which is on the left side of the Farm Store. (1-4+ adults depending on the size of your group- the rest of your group may find a seat at the picnic tables.)

Other useful information:

- Backpacks are not allowed in the orchard. If you are carrying medical supplies, that is allowed, but please consolidate as much as possible. Backpacks and baby carriages can be subject to inspection while on property.
- Carriages and strollers are not permitted on the hayride.
- Large groups (over 60) are not guaranteed to be on the same hayride. Your group will be transported to the same place and in a timely manner, but if the group is more than 60 people, we will have to split the group between two wagons. Please be prepared for this.
- Small groups may be placed on a hayride with other school groups.
- All costs are per person and include: all students, siblings, chaperones, parents, and teachers, etc.
- While you are out in the orchard only pick the amount of fruit that will fit in the apple picking bag. Please respect other school groups that will be picking from the same trees.
- Honey Pot Hill Orchards does not stock any auto-injectable devices or medicine. If you have students that have allergies, you must bring the necessary items to be prepared for any medical emergency.
- A Honey Pot Hill Orchards employee can only assist you in calling 911. A responsible adult in your group must carry a cell phone in case of an emergency.
